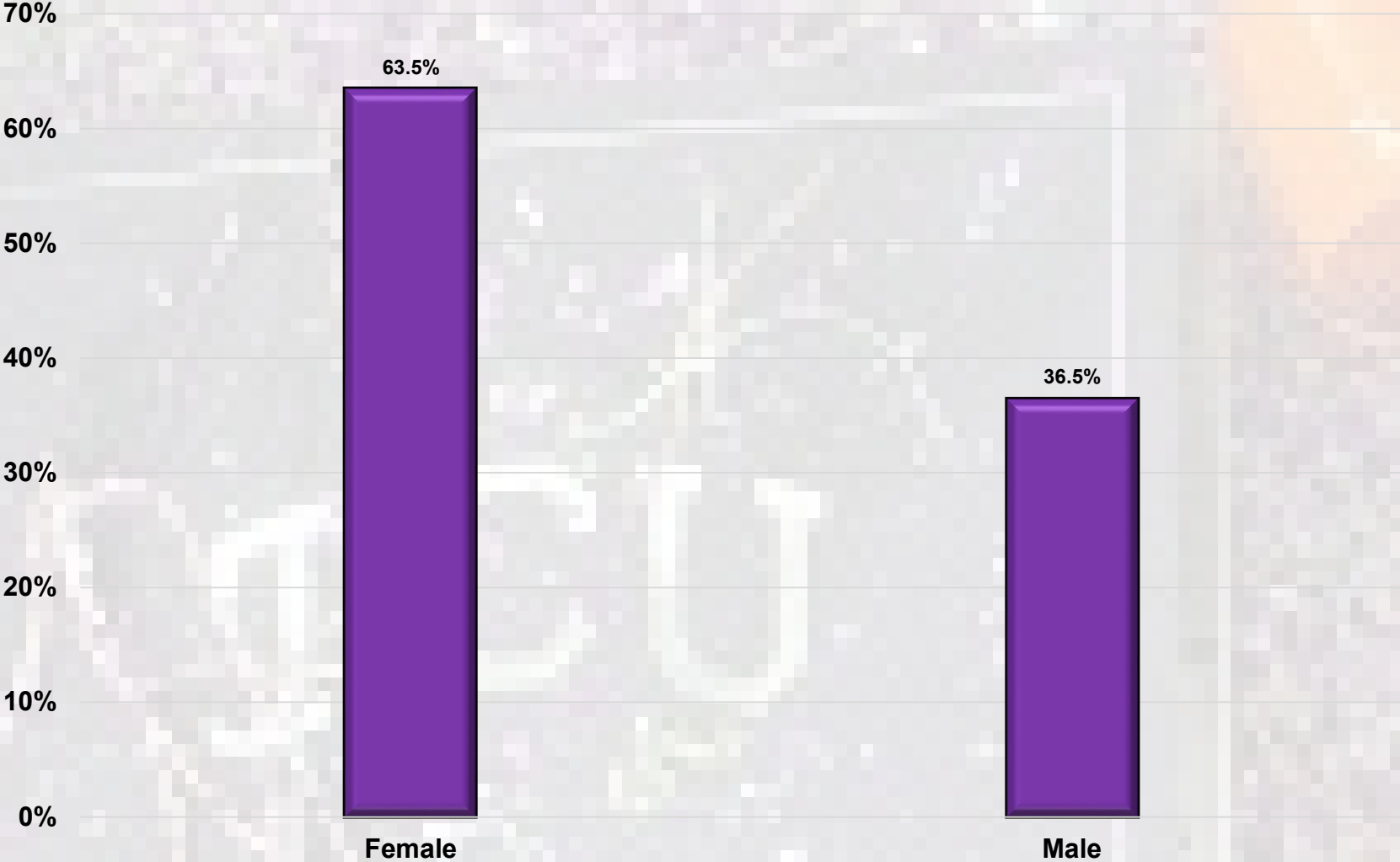

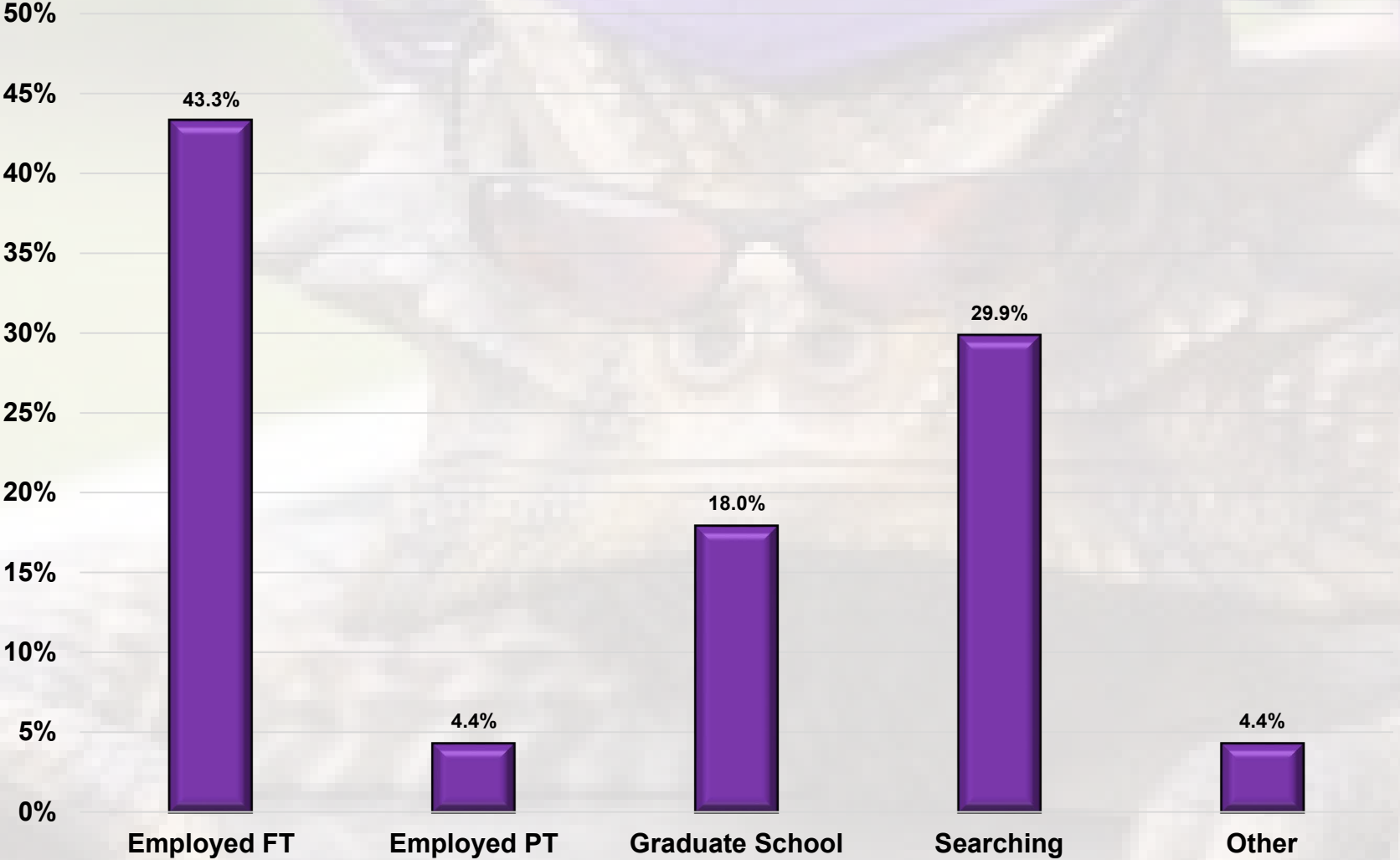

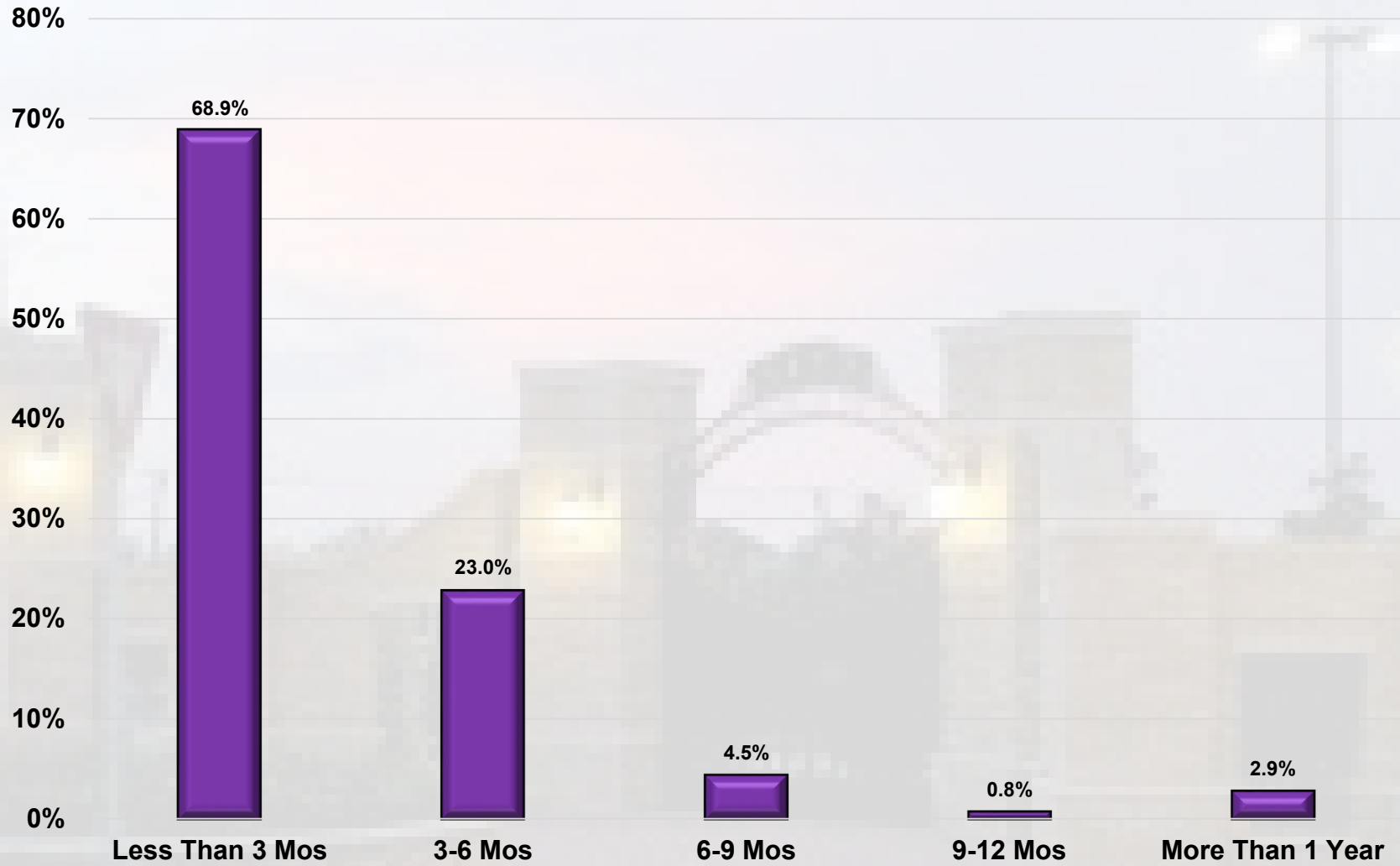

## Time Spent on Job Search



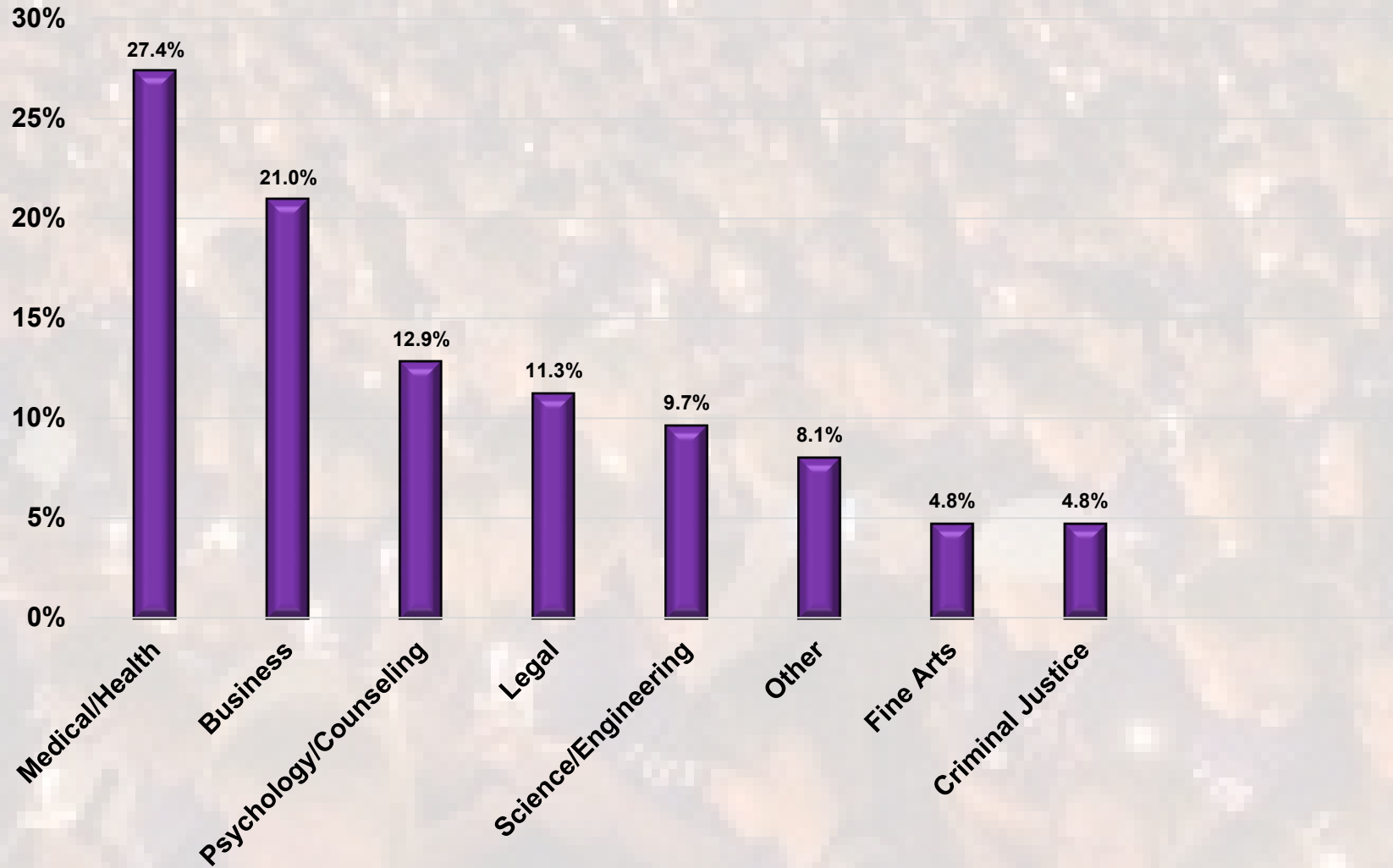
## Median Base Salary By College

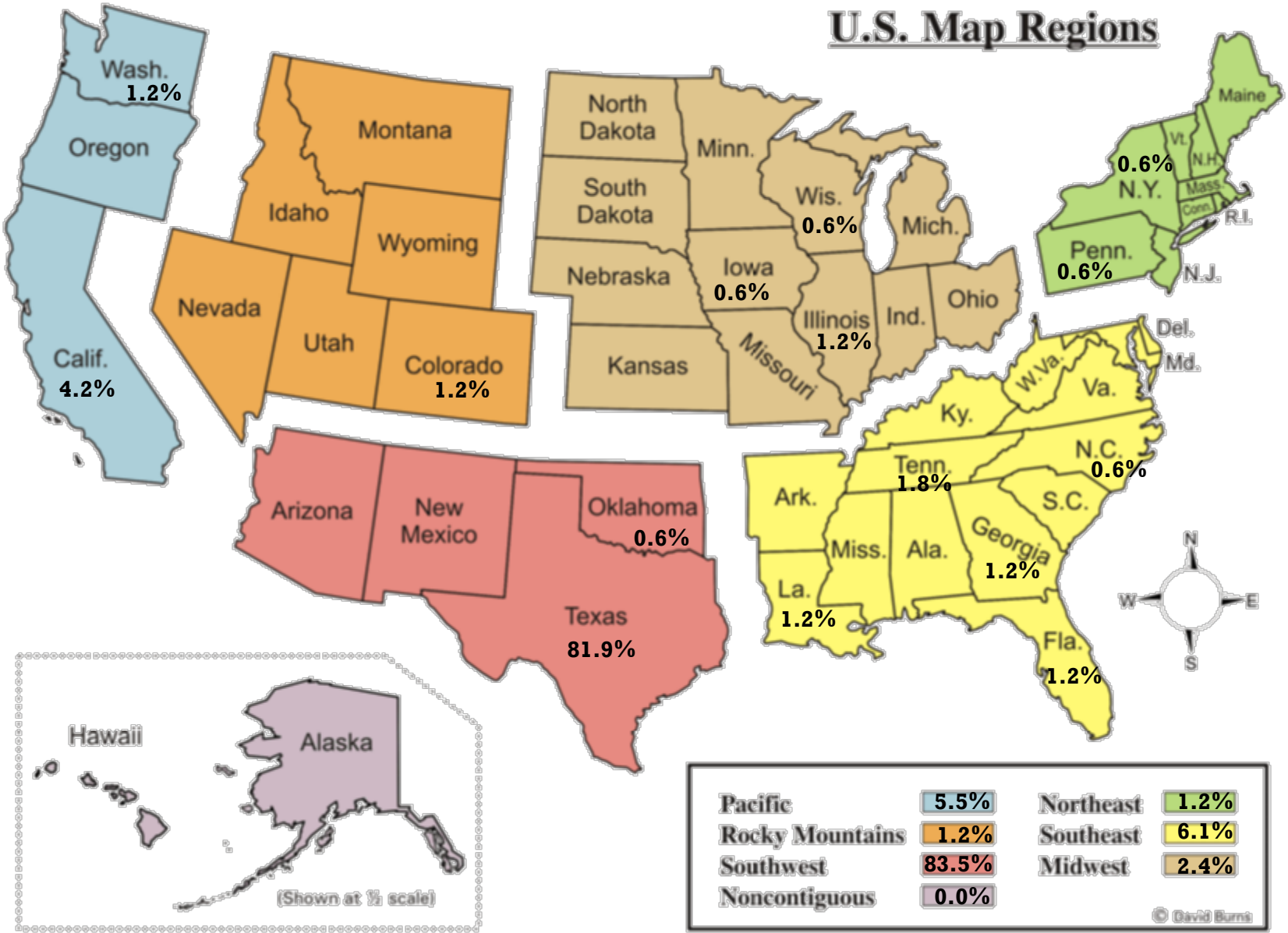


## Graduate School Area of Study



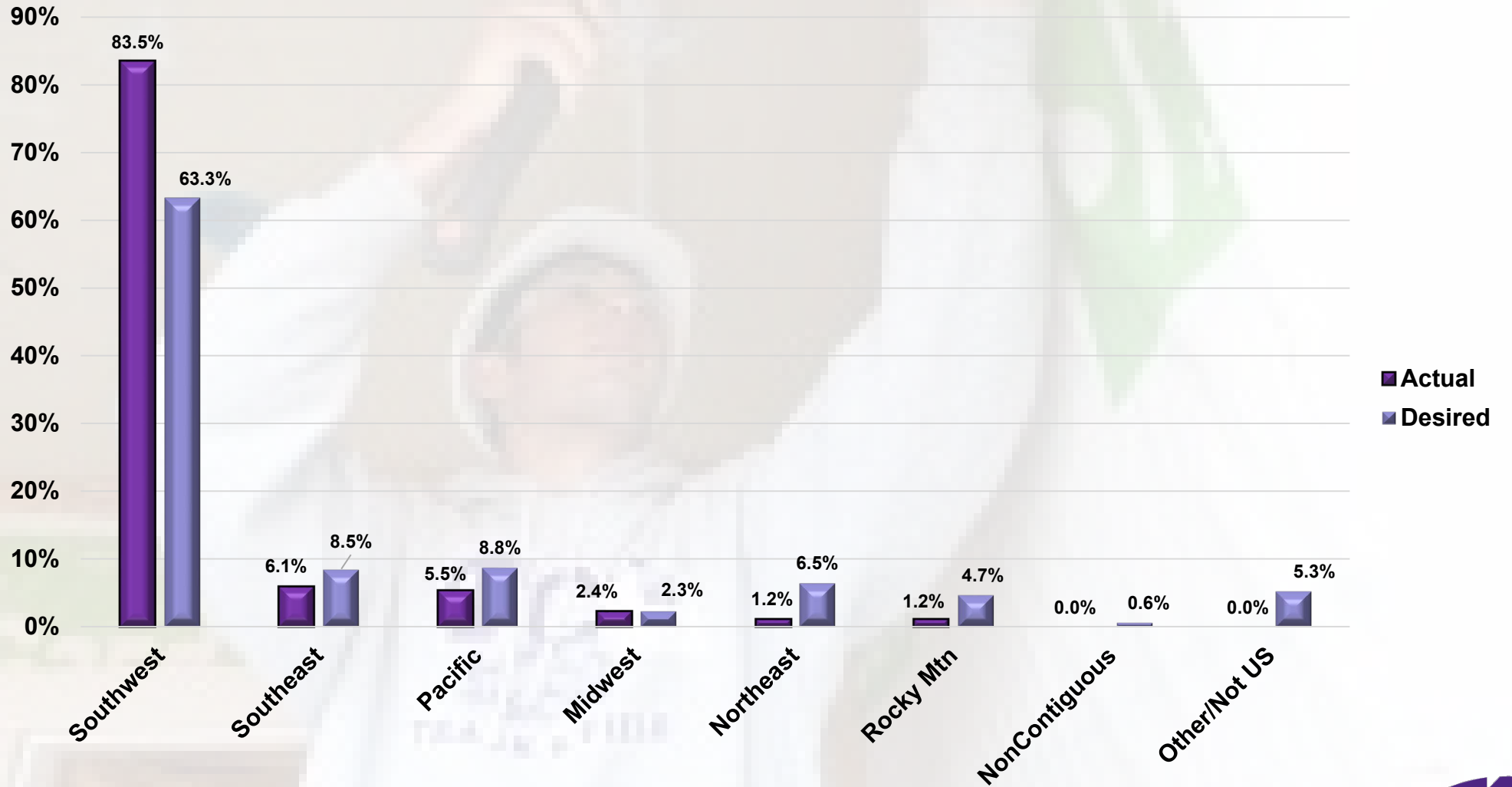


# U.S. Map Regions

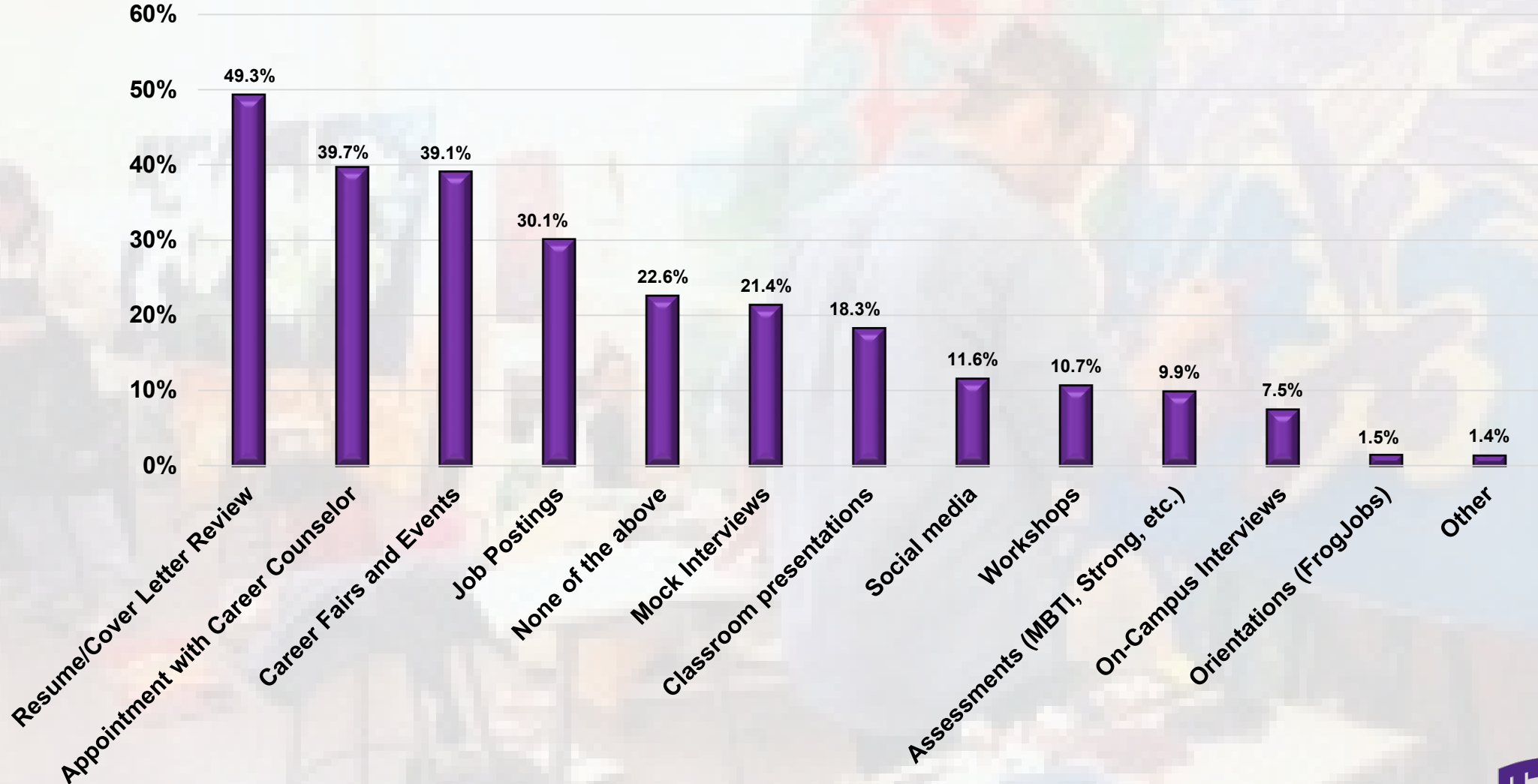

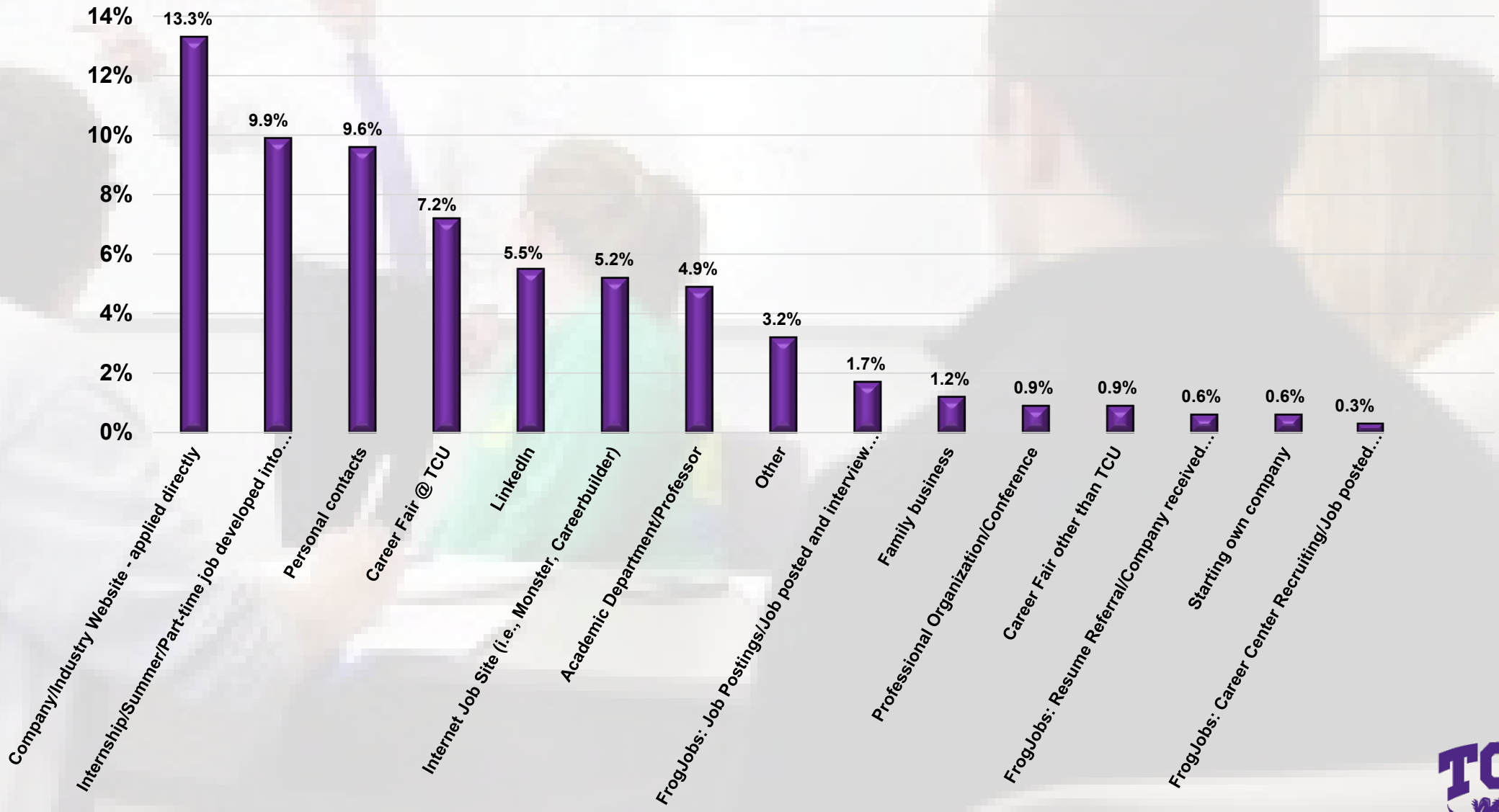
# Comparison of Actual vs Desired Job Location



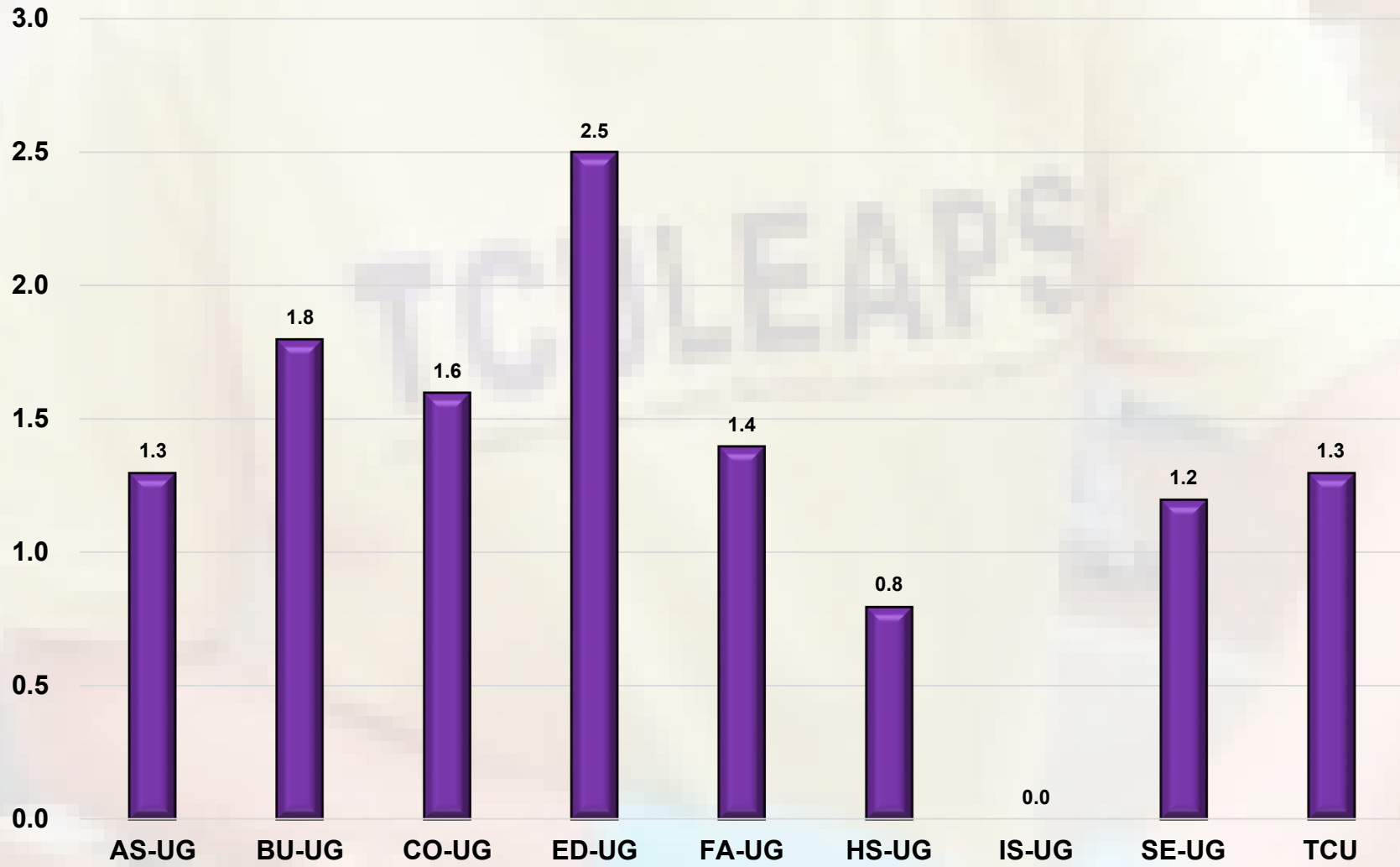

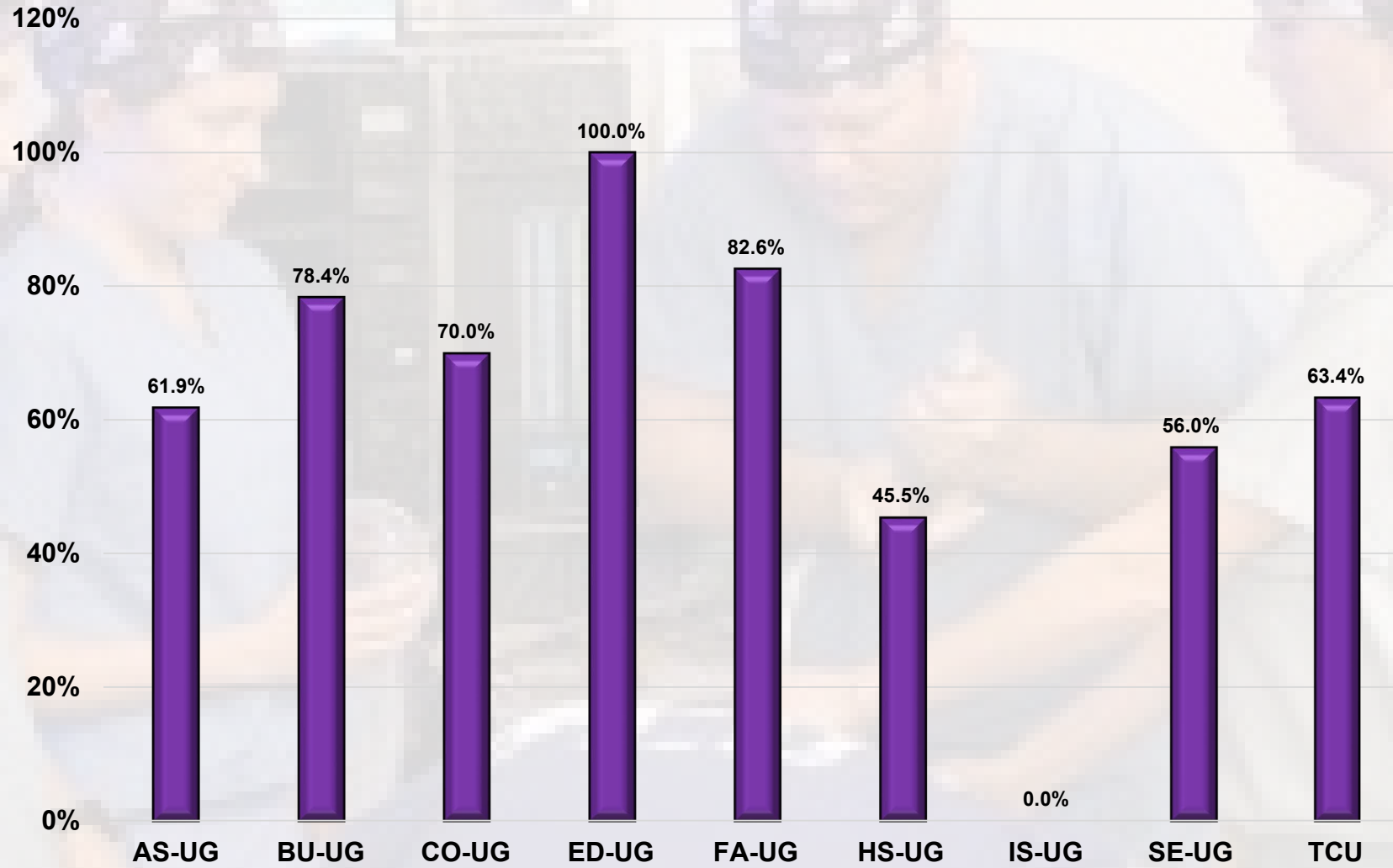
# Mean Number Internships By College

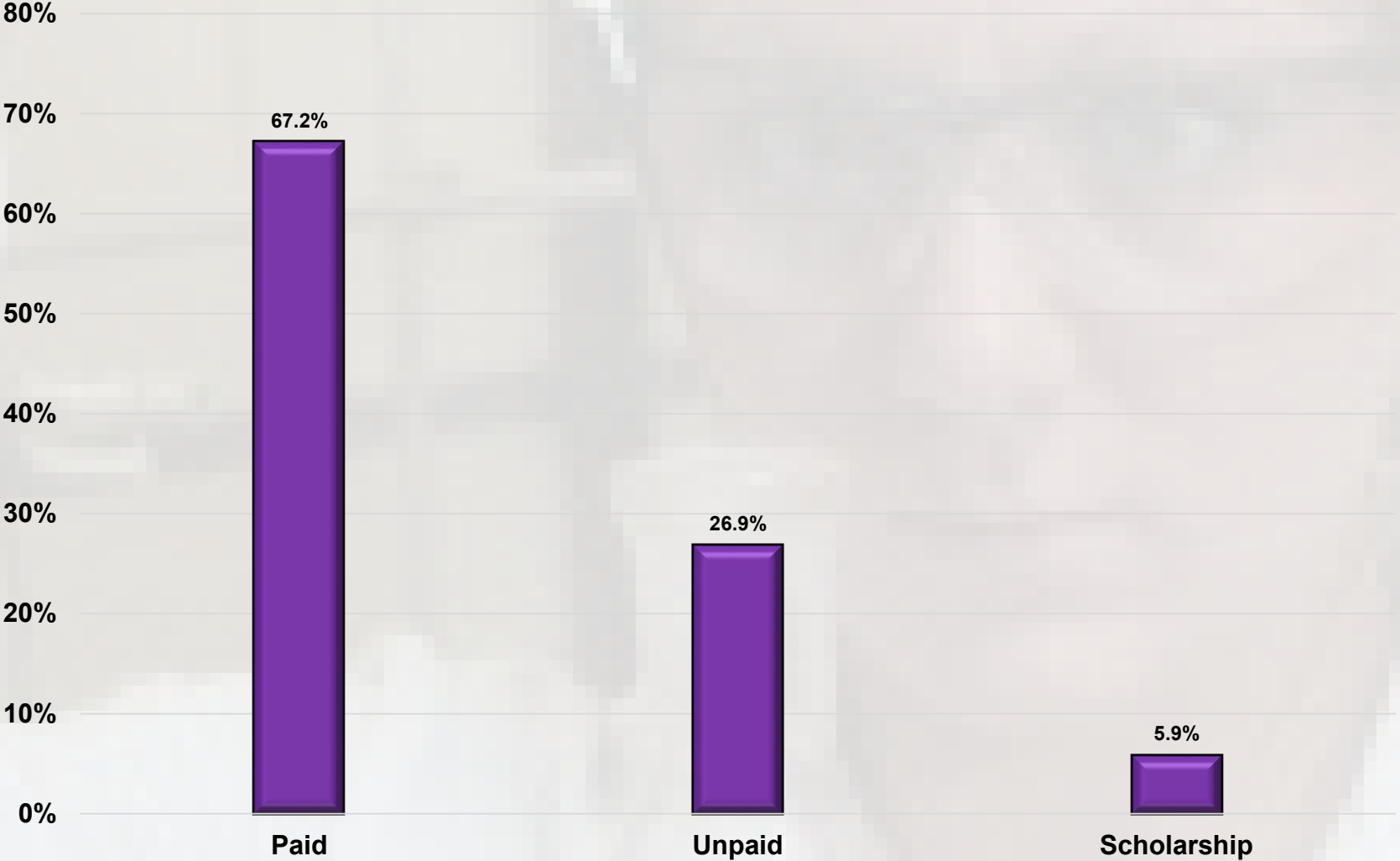
## Internships In Past Year By College



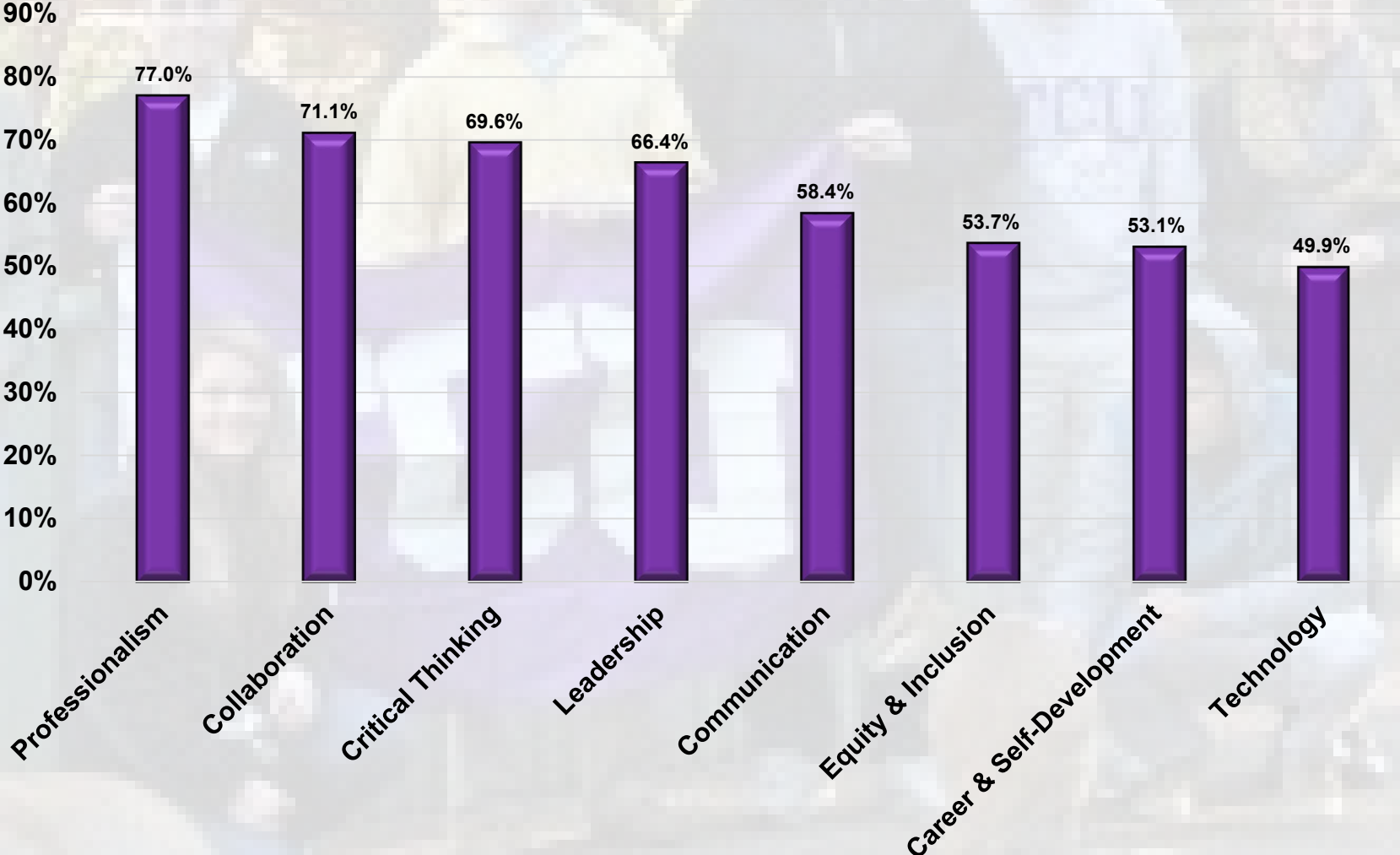

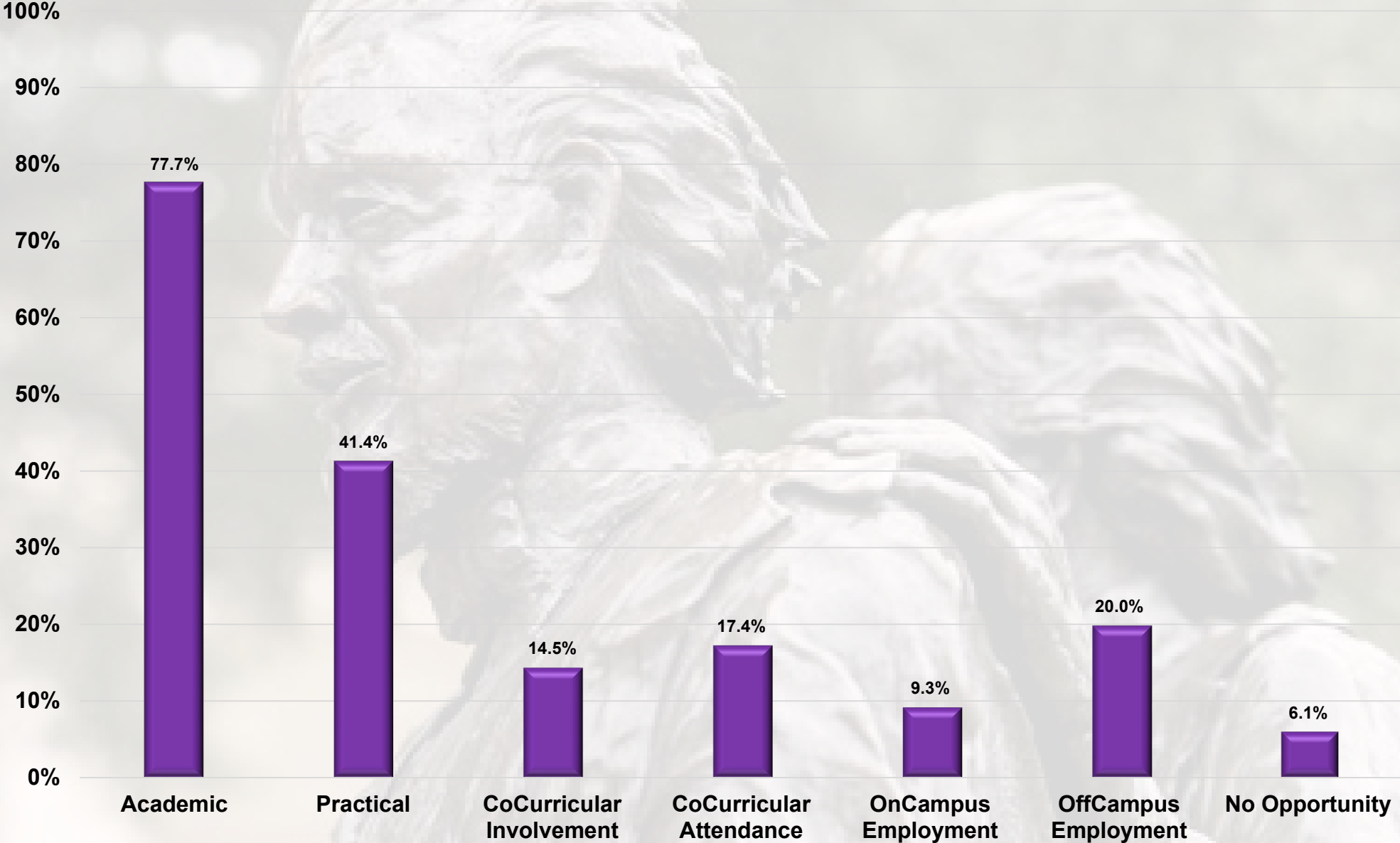

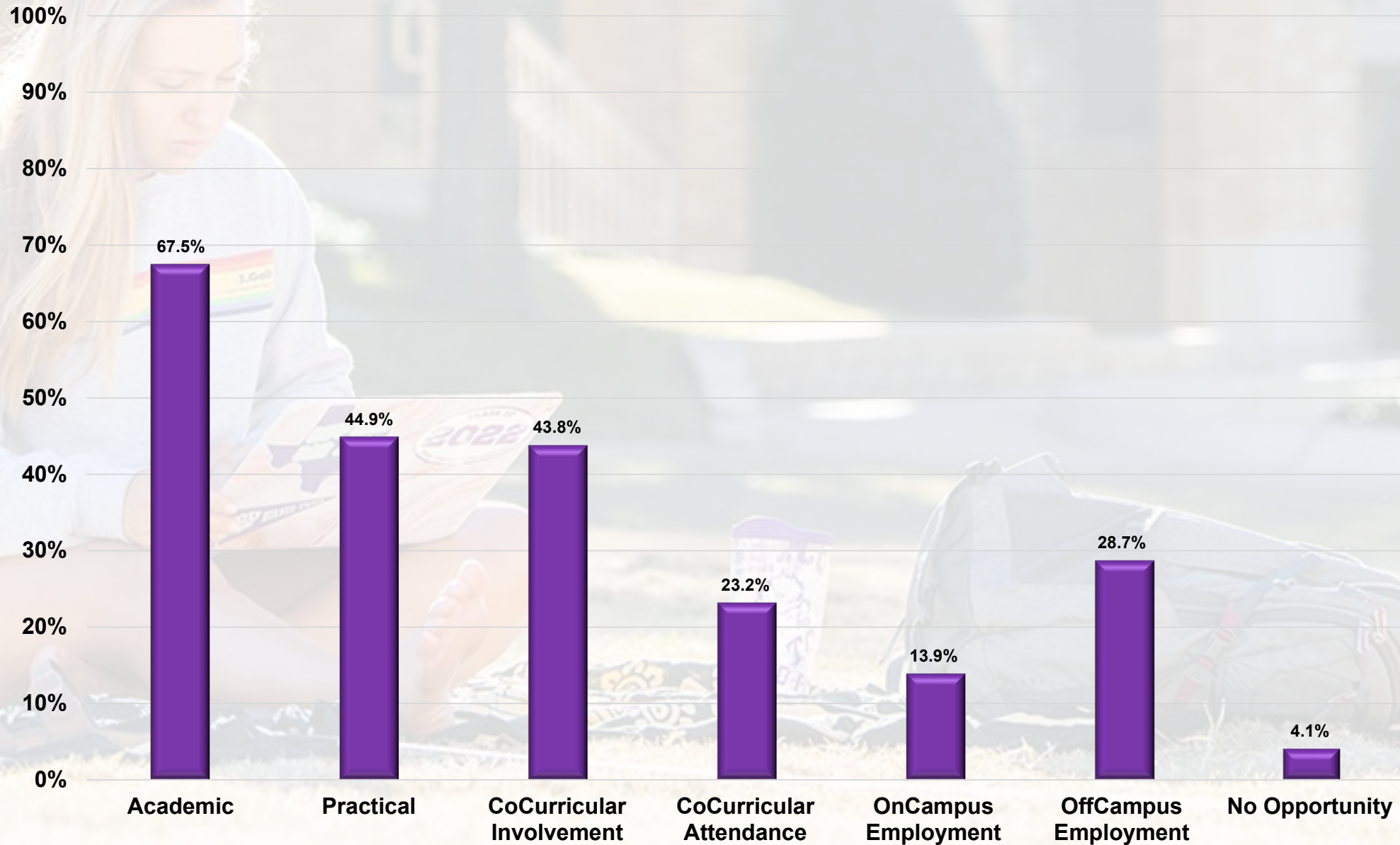

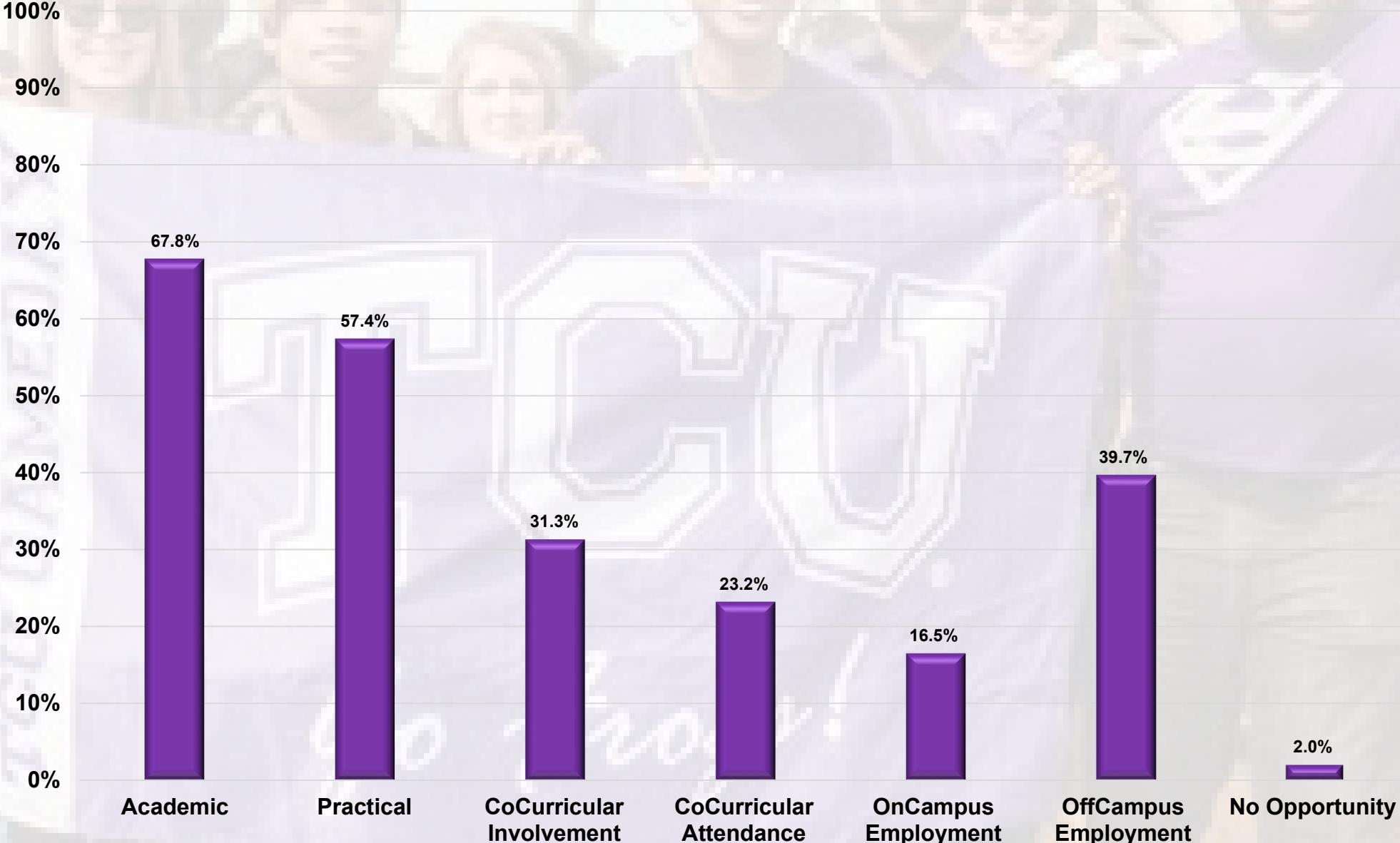

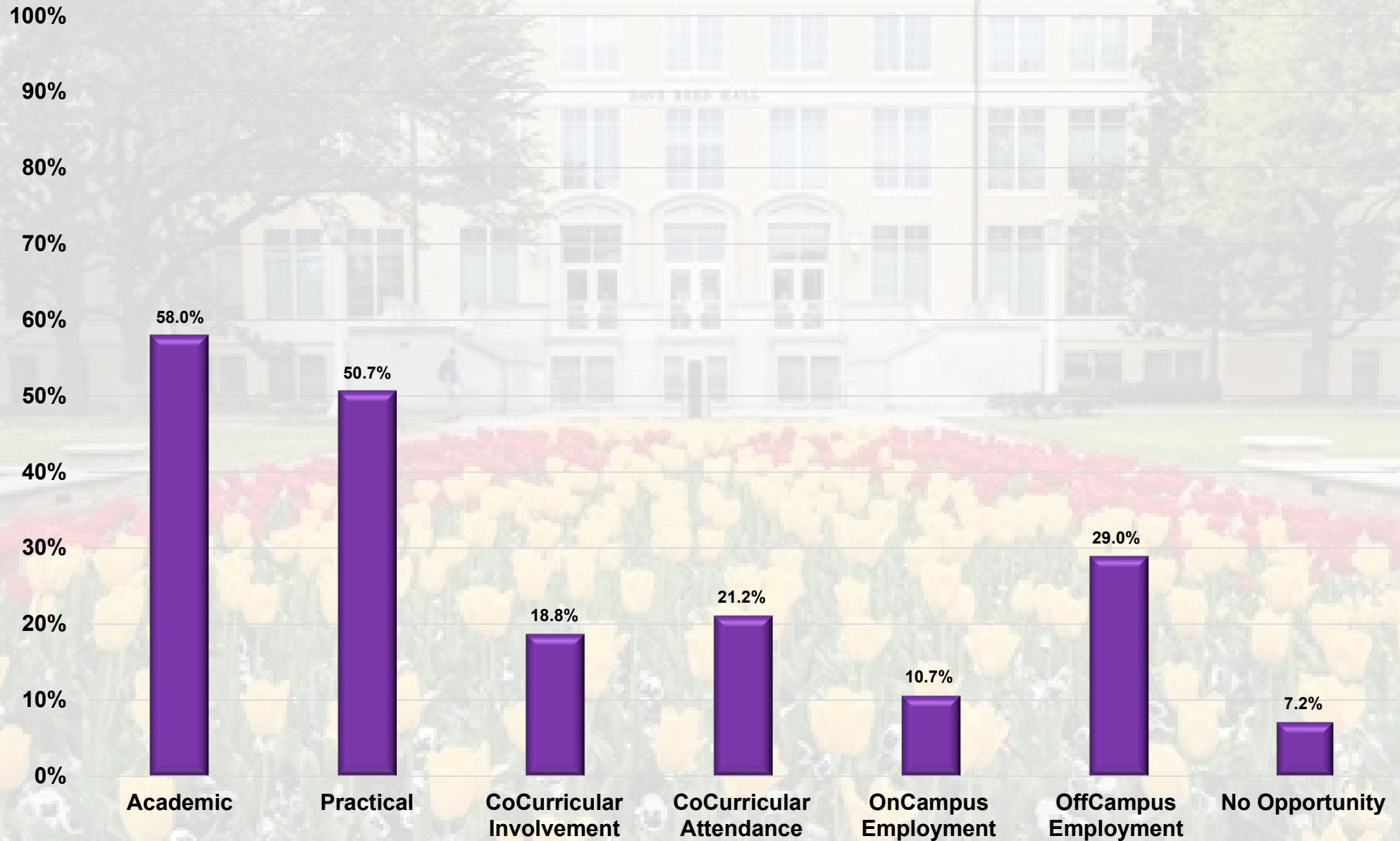

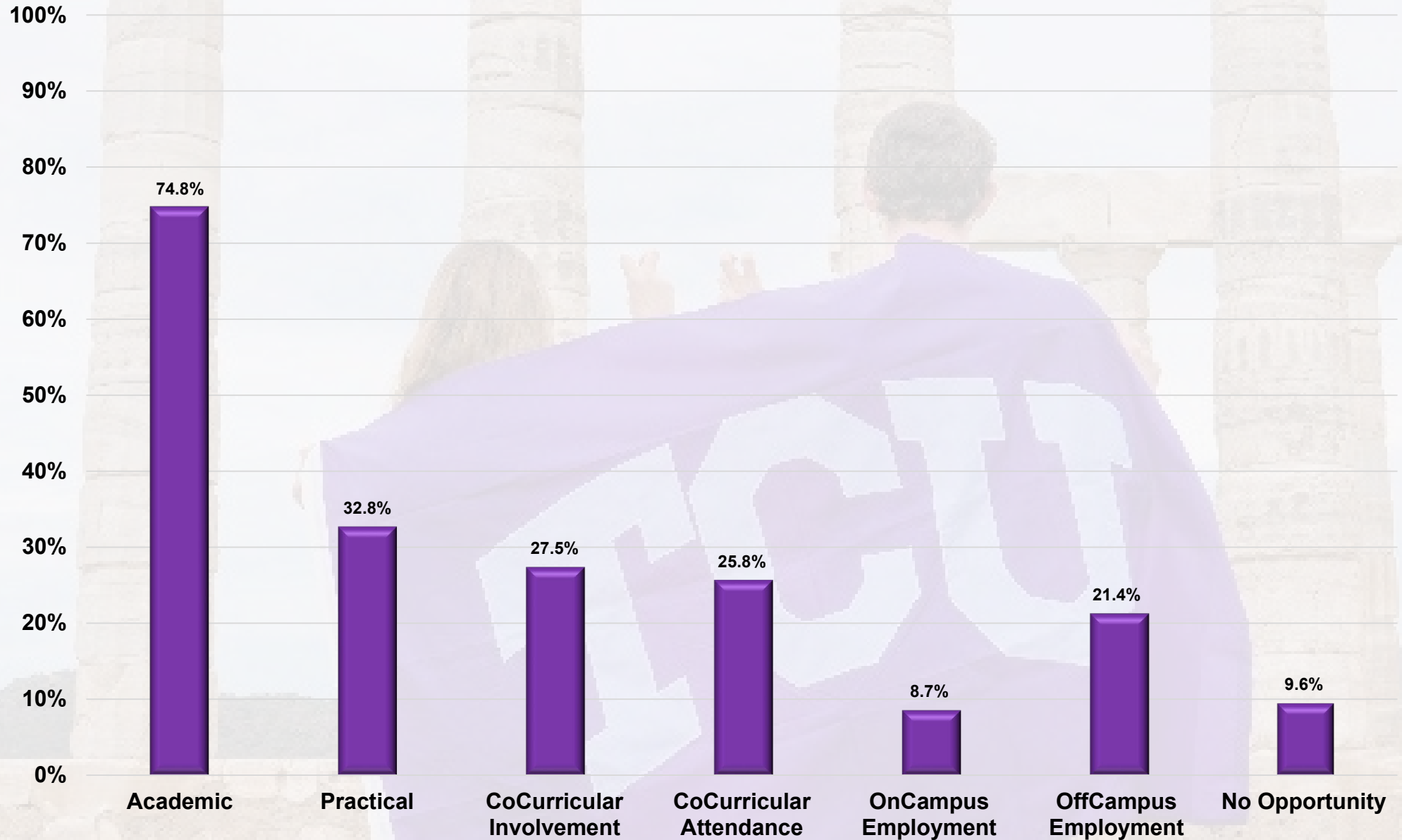

# COMPARED TO FALL 2020

- 6% increase in full-time employment; 69% found job in <3 months compared to 57%
- Graduate school enrollment roughly same
- On Average, salaries were up approximately \$5000
- Past year internships significantly up (15% - back to pre-pandemic level)
- Top Attributing Experiences
  - Academic: Communication (86%) & Critical Thinking (85%)
  - Practical: Professionalism (57%) & Critical Thinking (50%)
  - CoC Involve: Leadership (43%) & Collaboration (41%)
  - CoC Attend: Equity & Inclusion (26%) & Critical Thinking (26%)
  - OnC Employ: Professionalism (17%) & Collaboration (15%)
  - OffC Employ: Professionalism (40%) & Collaboration (31%)
  - No Opportunity: Equity & Inclusion (10%) & Career & Self-Development (7%)
- Most impactful experiences continue to be relationships/mentoring, study abroad, and co-curricular involvement
